

Parking Lot Paving Coming Soon



Everyone is tired of the trenches and mud from last year's sewer and drain projects plus the deteriorating condition of the main lot. Paving

has been in the budget for two years and it will finally be taken care of this summer. A contract has been signed with McCormick Construction- one of five that bid on the project- for the work which includes repairing the two trenches, milling the entire lot and paving for \$50,000. (Fifteen years ago they also paved the original lot for \$21,000). We do have the bulk of the funds, but this would be a good time, if you are so inclined, to help out with this long awaited special project. Your extra support for the Capital Improvement Fund (CIF) will be greatly appreciated.


