Thank you, Harborcreek (and Emmanuel) for calling me as your pastor! I'm really excited about the possibilities for us in ministry together in the weeks, months – the *years* – to come and I'm eager to become a settled member of the Erie and Harborcreek communities. But that settling is going to take a little longer than Mary Louise and I anticipated. The first contract on our house in Nashville – the one that would have allowed us to move earlier to Erie – was withdrawn. Fortunately, we received a good offer on October 23 and hope to close on November 22. It looks like we'll just barely get to spend Thanksgiving in our new home.

All of the anxiety and turmoil about our transition makes it clear that control is often an illusion. Or perhaps it's an illusion that *I'm* in control. Certainly, we've had to surrender to Realtors, stagers (don't get me started), sellers, buyers, inspectors, appraisers, an uncertain economy and rising interest rates, and even the weather.

Of course, we'll be fine. Mary Louise and I have been through far worse and know we are blessed to be able to do what we're doing. As a lesson in I'm-not-in-control, this one is fairly benign. But perhaps it's a reminder that there will be times of much greater anxiety, fear, uncertainty or calamity and that the only sure thing is the love and care of our Creator.

I know that my own faith has been strengthened by the necessity of trust. Over the last couple years, I've really been aware of God saying "this, not that" as I've tried to chart a course only to discover that God had something else in mind. And apparently that something else is Erie, Pennsylvania! Of course, now it seems obvious. And now that I'm here, I'm trusting that God will continue to present opportunities and challenges that will grow and strengthen our faith and that we'll have the wisdom and courage to take those opportunities and meet those challenges.

I hope that we'll take bold risks, try new things, and consider new ideas and perspectives while always looking for the Spirit's inspiration and guidance. I hope that we'll remember that God has called us together for a purpose *and* that we may not yet know what that is. And I hope that in the weeks, months – the *years* – to come that we will grow to trust each other even more. Because the one thing I'm sure of is that it is *God* who has brought us together and that we – God and you and I – are just getting started.

A total of 199 preschoolers, parents and grandparents traveled to Waterford at the end of September to attend our Port Farm's "Family Fun" Event. Everyone thoroughly enjoyed all of the many and varied activities. Every time we visit, there is more to see and do at the farm! It is an AWESOME place!!!!!

Then in October the preschool families visited Burch Farms for a wonderful and educational field trip. We toured the farm, were shown how their apple trees grow on wires, saw how BIG their refrigerated cooler is (big enough that we could all walk inside it!), were able to pick some apples off the trees, and saw how the apples get to "take a shower" before being put into the crates.
